

FBC Salinas Guidelines for In-Person Services

- Face masks are to be worn within the church at all times. Please bring your own, as we will not provide any when you arrive
 - Maintain social distancing of 6' at all times (sanctuary and all areas of the church)
 - Due to county guidelines, capacity is limited to 75 congregants
 - Doors will be open for contactless entrance
 - Please do not congregate in the lobby/narthex
 - Refreshments will not be served before, during, or after the service. (Coffee, doughnuts)
 - Communion Sundays (first Sunday of each month), we ask that you bring your own communion elements
 - Use hand sanitizer when entering the church
 - RESTROOMS ARE FOR EMERGENCY USE ONLY

- **PLEASE DO NOT COME TO CHURCH IF YOU ARE or FEEL ILL IN ANY WAY**
 - We may take your temperature at the door; we ask you self-screen temperature and symptoms at home
 - If you are 65 or over or have a pre-existing condition, please feel free to stay home and enjoy the worship service on YouTube

- Entrance and exit from the sanctuary is ONE WAY only
 - Family groups will be seated together in the sanctuary
 - Meet & Greet time is suspended for the duration
 - Bibles, hymnals, pens, Connection Cards are removed from the pews
 - Tithes and offerings are to be deposited in the offering boxes at the back of the sanctuary
 - Please wait for family groups to be dismissed from the sanctuary after the service
